note, I have not received official notification in writing. The details I do know are Nominations open Monday 8<sup>th</sup> February and close 17<sup>th</sup> February Credentialing Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> February at Woy Woy CWA Hall 9am to 1pm. Saturday 6th March also at Woy Woy CWA Hall 8am to 6pm. Ballot

At this stage, both sitting member Belinda Neal and former State Candidate Debra O'Neill have indicated they will stand for preselection. There may be others

I contacted Head Office and obtained via Brendan Kavanagh the officer in charge these matters, the criteria for eligibility to vote. In summary, they are as follows.

- 1. Member of relevant union if applicable
- 2. Enrolled to vote in Robertson
- 3. A member of a branch for not less than 2 years prior to calling of nominations ,signed the branch attendance book at least 4 times in that period and been a continuous financial member in that time. This means joining the branch prior to February 2008.
- 4. A member must have been a member of a branch for not less than 4 years prior to calling of nominations, and signed the attendance book at least 4 times in that period and been continuously financial in that time. This means joining the branch prior to February 2006.
- 5. Must have been correctly admitted to the branch according to the rules i.e. Was admitted, signed the attendance book and did so again within 4 calendar months.. This applies when eligibility is determined in both the 2 year rule and the 4 year rule i.e. 4 year rule admitted sometime in 5 years ago, in the 2 year rule, sometime in the period 3 years ago.

On these criteria, I believe the following members are eligible to vote. However, I do not have the branch list of financial members which normally comes out in February. This may adversely affect some people listed.
