Polis and Worms

You will need :

- To print out the game board, baby tokens and Antony Green Action Cards.
- Stick them all on some card and cut it all out.
- Stick the tokens to a 10c piece as well if you want them to stand up for action.
- Try and do the game board on A3 or on a few sheets of A4 stuck together if you can. The more hastily cobbled together and crapper the better as it will be authentic and not unlike this whole stupid election campaign.

You will also need :

- Dice
- A jug of Bandicoot Breezer or similar
- Three or more friends
- A working telly



The Rules

- To start, everyone rolls the dice. (Use two or three dices or whatever, it's a democracy) The person with the highest number becomes The Giant Baby.
 - The Giant Baby goes first, and then the person on their left etc.
- If you land on a poll result, go up it. If it ends on a blue square, Drink for Democracy!
- If you land on a worm go down it. If it ends on a yellow square, Drink for News Ltd!
 - If you land on Antony Green's Cloned head in a jar (purple square) you must Choose an Antony Green Action Card and do what it says.
- If you land on a "Kiss the Baby" square, you must kiss whoever is The Giant Baby unless you are the Giant Baby in which case you Drink!
 - You must roll an exact number to finish.

The first person to 100 wins the election and the title of Official Giant Baby.

Extra Rules

If it is your turn and someone on telly says :

- "Corangamite" you must Drink! and / or do the Mr Shuffles stampy dance
- "I'm calling Herbert for..." Drink and / or make a Christopher Pyne squeaky noise
- If anyone says "Knife edge" or "Hung Parliament" or "Outlying booths" and it is your turn then Drink! unless you are the giant baby and then everyone else Drink! If you see a hologram or a channel nine's virtual studio shits itself, drain your glass.
- If you see Stephen Smith, yell obscenities at his hair (only on telly, not in real life)
 - If Bandt wins Melbourne, grow a goatee and check your carbon footprint

Disclaimer - This game has not been played, let alone tested so don't tell me about any mistakes they are all on purpose. Also drinking games are stupid and you people should know better. Feel free to play without the drinking part, but the kissing part is like compulsory just like voting.

Give this on a piece of card and cut it out. Don't make me do a stupid diagram, you can work it out. When you land on an Antony Green Cloned Head in a Jar Purple Square, take an action card and do the action! For Australia!

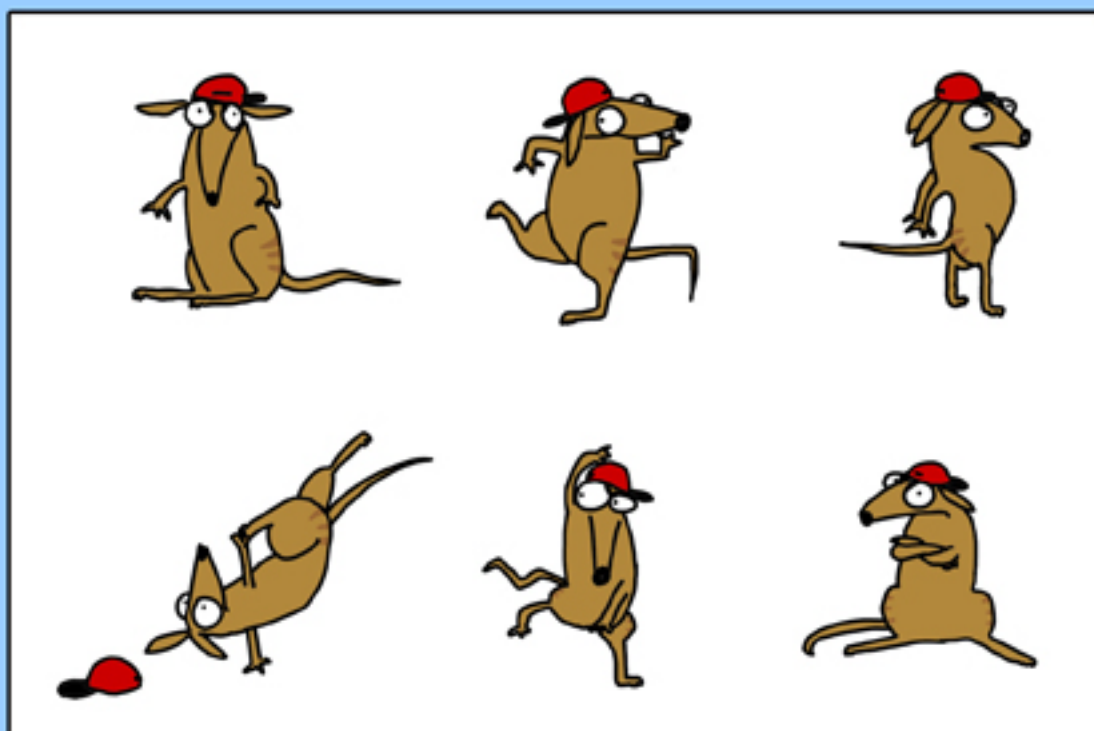

Drink



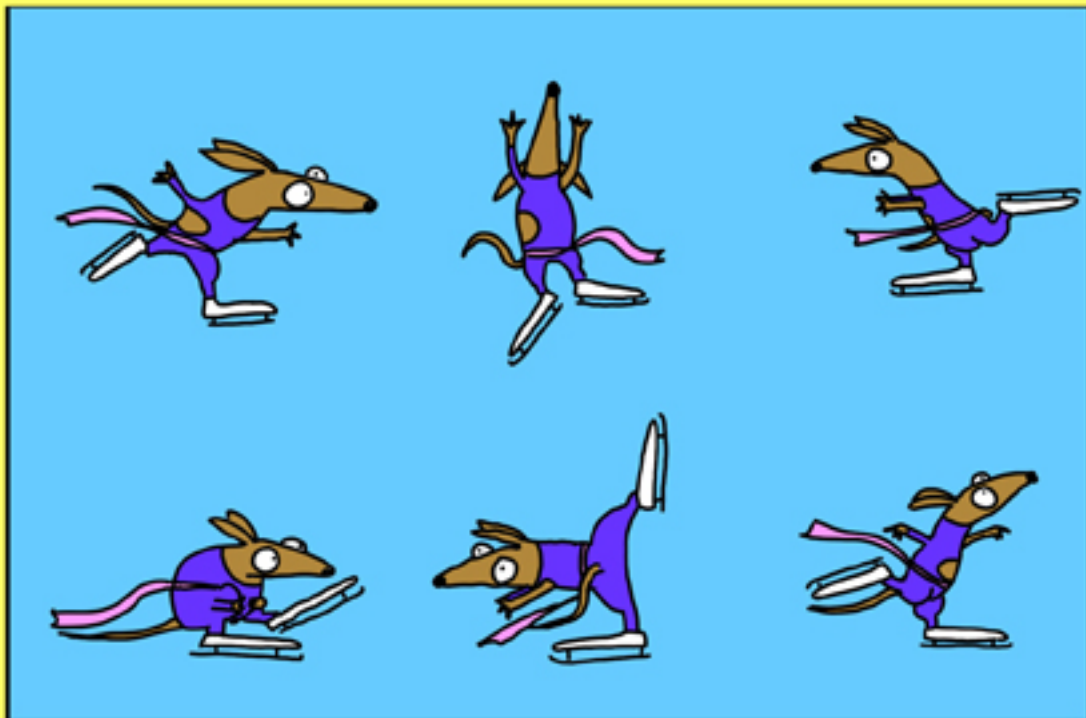
