# MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGEMENT ON LIABILITY

The Plaintiff seeks summary judgement on liability, as provided for by section 153 of the District Court Rules.

- The Plaintiff filed a "Notice of Proceeding" and "Statement of Claim" in the New Zealand District Court, Auckland on 13<sup>th</sup> October 2008, under the Fair Trading Act 1986.
- The "Notice of Proceeding" and "Statement of Claim" were accepted and signed by the Deputy Register Mr. G McKay and given the Civ No: 08/004/2516

### The 1st Defendant

- The 1<sup>st</sup> Defendant is an Italian registered corporation. The "Notice of Proceeding" and "Statement of Claim" was served on the 1<sup>st</sup> Defendant at their Italian offices via Magnadola, 15 - 31045 Motta di Livenza, Treviso, Italy at 11.23am on the 21<sup>st</sup> October 2008.
- Under the rules of the District Court, the 1<sup>st</sup> Defendant had 50 days after 21<sup>st</sup> October 2008 to file a defence.
- 5. This 50-day period has now expired and the 1<sup>st</sup> Defendant has failed to file a Defence in accordance with the District Court rules.
- Under District Court Rule No. 153, the Plaintiff seeks the court to give summary judgment on liability against the 1<sup>st</sup> Defendant and proceed to a hearing on the issue of quantum.

## The 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Defendants

- 7. The "Notice of Proceeding" and "Statement of Claim" was served on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Defendants on the 13<sup>th</sup> October 2008.
- The 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Defendants have failed to file a Defence in accordance with the rules of the District Court. Instead, the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Defendants have filed an "Appearance Reserving Rights".
- 9. The 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Defendants have stated that they;

"oppose the Plaintiff's claim and are of the opinion that it neither complies with the Rules nor is in a format to which they can plead"

10. The Plaintiff contests the claims of the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Defendants. The Plaintiff has detailed 4 separate representations made by the Defendants, in accordance with the District Court Rules.

- a) Representation No 1 is detailed in paragraphs 66-67 of the Plaintiff's Statement of Claim. A copy of this representation in its original form was included in the attachments to the Statement of Claim and labeled "3A".
- b) Representation No 2 is detailed in paragraphs 68-71 of the Plaintiff's Statement of Claim. A copy of this representation in its original form was included in the attachments to the Statement of Claim and labeled "3B".
- c) Representation No 3 is detailed in paragraph 72 of the Plaintiffs Statement of Claim. A copy of this representation in its original form was included in the attachments to the Statement of Claim and labeled "3C".
- d) Representation No 4 is detailed in paragraphs 73-75 of the Plaintiff's Statement of Claim. A copy of this representation in its original form was included in the attachments to the Statement of Claim and labeled "3C".
- 11. In accordance with the District Court Rules, the Plaintiff detailed in its pleadings that the above representations contravened;
  - Part 1, section 9 of the Fair Trading Act 1986
  - Part 1, section 10 of the Fair Trading Act 1986
  - Part 1. section 13(i) of the Fair Trading Act 1986
  - Part 1, section 22 of the Fair Trading Act 1986
- 12.In accordance with the District Court rules the Plaintiff has detail extensive particulars in relation to the Defendant's above mentioned contraventions of the Fair Trading Act
- 13. Having failed to file a defence within the rules, the Plaintiff seeks the court to give summary judgment on liability against the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Defendants and proceed to a hearing on the issue of quantum.
- 14. The Plaintiff requests a hearing on the issue of quantum at the earliest possible date, as the Plaintiff's loss and damage from the Defendants' contraventions of the Fair Trading Act 1986 continue to accrue.
