1. What would you do to get our dollar below 80 cents? Will you guarantee to lower the dollar?

Fact: All the experts agree that the biggest challenge for our manufactures is the High Australian dollar.

2. Will you abolish the use of s457 visas and have all workers treated as equal permanent citizens?
